Celebrating 10 Years

The **Justice Will Be Served! Campaign** is a tri-state area wide campaign that unites service workers from different communities and trades to fight the long hours, second-class wages, stolen tips, and other sweatshop conditions that workers face in this growing industry. Our organizing campaign has expanded from the Chinatown restaurant industry to restaurants in New Jersey, Upstate NY, and Long Island; delivery, supermarket, deli, hotel, and nail salon workers. **JWBS! highlights include:**

- In the early 1990's organizing at Silver Palace/ New Silver Palace restaurant and Jing Fong restaurant achieves a 40-hour workweek and compliance with minimum wage laws in the Chinatown restaurant industry. During this time, the "Campaign to End Slave Labor" and the week-long "Students for Workers' Rights" hunger strike promotes awareness of sweatshop conditions in the U.S.
- In 2002, workers prevented the Restaurant Association of NY State from freezing minimum wage for tipped employees at \$2.90/ hour, winning the first raise for NY State tipped-employees in more than ten years.
- Last year, Latino and Chinese workers at Zen Palate restaurant organized to win a settlement for more than one hundred workers, shortening work hours and bringing the restaurant's several locations under labor law compliance.
- With the leadership of Chinatown restaurant workers demanding an end to tip-stealing, workers at 88 Palace restaurant earlier this year won a landmark federal court decision impacting all tipped employees. The decision rules that employers are prohibited from taking workers' tips, regardless of whether it's labeled as a service charge or other name.
- In 2007 JWBS! is organizing at many workplaces, including Food Bazaar Supermarket in Brooklyn, East Buffet Restaurant in Long Island, Majestic Restaurant in New Jersey, and Ollie's Restaurant, Saigon Grill Restaurant, Republic Restaurant, and Azzure Deli in Manhattan.
