

WORKERS DEMAND APOLOGY AND COMPENSATION FROM DYNASTY SUPERMARKET'S PHILLIP WU

Phillip Wu, the owner of Dynasty Supermarket and Golden Bridge Restaurant, made slanderous statements against restaurant workers in Chinatown.

- First, Mr. Wu claimed that management was able to “buy off” 318 Restaurant Union members who were applying for jobs at Golden Bridge Restaurant.
- Second, at a September 29, 2004 press conference, Phillip Wu, through his spokesperson, stated that the union workers applying for jobs at the Golden Bridge Restaurant and the union itself are “evil forces.”

In addition to slander, Phillip Wu has used intimidation and threats against the workers.

- On September 14, 2004, Golden Bridge Restaurant was handing out job applications at 85 Eldridge Street. Phillip Wu's staff used video cameras to record 318 Restaurant Union workers who were applying for jobs and threatened the workers' union representative.

Phillip Wu, the owner of Golden Bridge and Dynasty Supermarket, has slandered, insulted, and threatened workers. These statements have caused great harm and injury to the workers' good name and reputation in the community.

The workers who have been harmed by these statements demand that Phillip Wu of Dynasty Supermarket publicly apologize and compensate them for their injuries. Mr. Wu has damaged the honor and good name of the workers and the union. He has also inflicted upon the workers severe emotional distress with his threats. The workers will continue to picket all Phillip Wu family supermarkets as long as Phillip Wu refuses to (1) apologize and (2) to compensate the workers and the union for the harm he has done.

The actions of the restaurant workers and 318 Restaurant Workers Union are being supported by the workers of Jing Fong Restaurant, Harmony Palace Restaurant, 88 Palace Restaurant, Ocean Palace, Jade Plaza, and CLM Restaurant.
