**Latina Women Worked Up to 7 days, 84 hours/week,
for as little as \$2/hour**

The women worked for as long as almost four years at both stores, sometimes even 16-17 hours a day with only a 10-minute lunch break; when the workers asked for their lunch breaks, the boss, Jaeshik Kim, said: **"You shouldn't eat so much, you're so fat."**

Jaeshik Kim forced each of them to have a cell phone, deducting costs from their monthly pay, so that he could call them whenever he pleased, as late as 10pm to ask the cost of certain items or to come to work. When one woman started a family with her husband, he said: **"You're so stupid, to get pregnant. None of you women should have boyfriends or kids- that will take away time and dedication from work here."**

The Korean owners treated the Latinas as second-class citizens--paying them less than Korean workers for the same job, yelling at them for eating while allowing Korean workers to take hour-long lunches, compelling them to stay until midnight to cover shifts of late Korean workers, and **firing Latinos when they complained about the sweatshop conditions.**

The workers have filed a federal lawsuit. They are supported by elected officials, community organizations, and workers from other industries including restaurant workers from Saigon Grill, Flor De Mayo and Ollie's.
